O Lord you are my God; I will exalt you and praise your name.

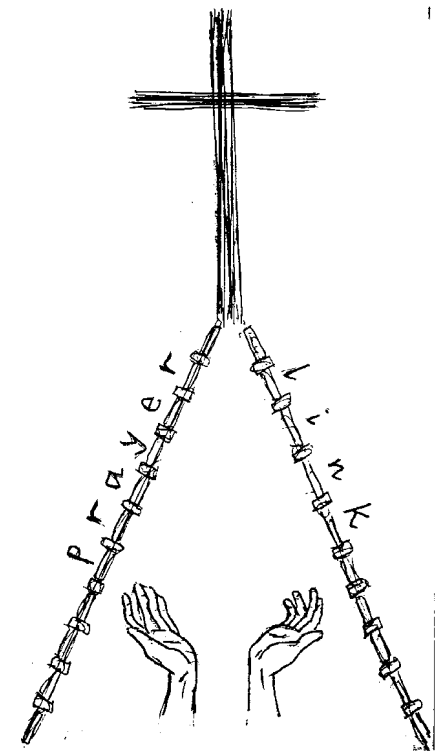
